



## HOW TO ENROLL

1. Call (334) 687-2451 to schedule an informational meeting.
2. Complete an application packet and submit all required documentation.

### Required Documents

- Driver's License or State Issued ID
  - Social Security Card
  - Birth Certificate
  - Proof of Address (utility bill)
  - Letter/documentation stating the student has dropped out (Exit Form)
  - School attendance record (if still enrolled in high school)
  - High School Transcripts
  - Proof of income (pay stubs, bank statements, parent tax returns, unemployment insurance records, public assistance records, court documentation showing foster child/child support payments)
  - Court Contact/Documentation (Foster Care)
  - Social Security Administration Disability Records
  - Court Documentation, Police Records, Letter of Parole/Probation (Youth/Adult Offender)
3. Interview with Eufaula Housing Authority (EHA) YouthBuild Staff.
  4. Complete Mental Toughness Orientation (MTO).
  5. Final interview with Director.

Once accepted into EHA YouthBuild Program you are eligible to enter YouthBuild Boot Camp, an eight week education and human development program to provide you a jumpstart for GED Ready testing.

Once YouthBuild Boot Camp is complete you may enroll in Wallace GED Prep & Construction Training. Additionally you may be co-enrolled in other community partner programs for additional benefits.

EHA YouthBuild does not charge for their educational services. EHA YouthBuild does conduct background checks and drug testing. Results of testing will not exclude you from the program but allows us to evaluate what services will need to be provided to you.
